  - ❑ NMIMS Management Review Journal (SAGE Journal) is fully open access without any submission charge of APC.
  - ❑ Edited books published by NMIMS faculty are available for open access and download.
  - ❑ Educational audio-visual educational resources (videos) are accessible to all.

## Dialogue with other knowledge systems and engagement with societal actors

- ❑ A joint initiative of a Geologist and the President of NMIMS University in Shirpur, Maharashtra resulted in an astounding ground water recharge success. School of Agricultural Sciences & Technology was established in Shirpur, 2019 to undertake research and scale up such initiatives
- ❑ Civic engagement through centre for social entrepreneurship and sustainability management
- ❑ Active partnerships with Non-Government Organizations and civic bodies to implement initiatives such as re-cycling plastics waste, cleaning of water bodies and other initiatives
- ❑ Focus on leveraging indigenous knowledge with modern science (e.g., Ayurveda, Yoga, Efficacy of weather forecasting models)
- ❑ Sharing knowledge with academic fraternity, industry and society through popular media articles, addresses and panel discussions on public forums.
- ❑ Offering mentoring to early stage start-ups and MSMEs through Incubation centre and school of entrepreneurship and family managed businesses

# Public Engagement

- ❑ In a first-of-its-kind initiative, NGO Salaam Bombay Foundation (SBF) conducted 'Dolphin Tank(i) 2.0' in partnership with SBM, NMIMS on March 18, 2023. This event was conducted under SBF's Entrepreneurship Incubator for grassroots adolescent entrepreneurs from the slums of Mumbai and Pune. The Dolphin Tanki program, which operates under the slogan "Nurturing Grassroot Adolescent Entrepreneurs," offers in-kind donations to the most potential business ventures to aid in the growth of their entrepreneurship endeavors.
- ❑ NMIMS actively collaborate and participate in creating awareness on waste segregation, recycling of plastic bottles and best practices towards a cleaner environment through a "Bottle for Change" campaign run by Bisleri (Bottled water company) to build plastic recycling awareness and collection drives in schools, colleges, corporate offices, malls, festive & social gatherings, events, etc.
